There is no such statement from FEMA, you will not find it in the NOFO...we (OHSP) have decided (as the SAA) that “security fencing” should be: **chain link, wrought iron, aluminum security fencing**. Ideally 6’ or taller, but we will accept up to 5’. Willing to discuss any other...but security must be though about in any decision.

A 4’ fence is hardly “security fencing”.

Our federal grant requirements do NOT supersede your town zoning laws...please seek a variance for the additional height requirement.
