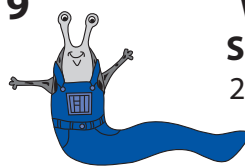

Items accepted: Computers (Desktops & Laptops), Monitors (Cathode-Ray Tube & Flat Panel), Televisions (Cathode-Ray Tube & Flat Panel), Telecommunication Equipment (Telephones, Cellular Phones), Telephone Mainframes, Copiers, Digital Cameras, DVD players, E-book Readers, Fax Machines, Keyboards, Mice, Cables, Wiring, Circuit Boards, Modems, Power Supplies, MP3 players, Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs), Printers, Scanners, Stereo and Radio Equipment, VCRs, Audio Visual Equipment, Typewriters, Mainframe Equipment & Controllers, Camcorders.

Items NOT accepted: Household batteries, CDs, DVDs, VHS tapes, cassette tapes. (Household batteries may be put in the regular trash. For other batteries, see Household Hazardous Waste Days on the back page.)

Proper Disposal of Rx Medications

Project Medicine Drop is a medicine-collection program sponsored by the Somerset County Sheriff's Office, the Somerset County Solid Waste Management Division and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration. Residents can bring medications to the Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off events that are held at different locations around the county for their convenience.

Medications should be dropped off in their original packages or bottles with personal information such as name and address removed. The name of the medication should be visible. **Illegal drugs, needles or sharps should not be brought to the drop-off.**

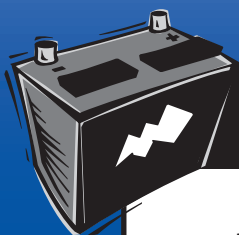

Waste will not be accepted from commercial vehicles.

What CANNOT be collected?

- Unknown or unidentified material
- Pentachlorophenol
- 2, 4, 5-TP (Silvex)
- Gas cylinders
- Tires
- Infectious waste
- 55 gallon drums
- Air conditioners/dehumidifiers (any refrigerant)
- Electronic waste
- Humidifiers
- Dioxins
- PCBs
- Smoke alarms
- Carbon monoxide detectors
- Explosives

What CAN be collected?

- Banned or outdated pesticides
- Wastes only in their original, labeled containers
- Auto products: Motor oil (5 gallon maximum), antifreeze, transmission fluids, brake fluids, wet-cell car batteries & used oil filters
- Fluorescent tubes & compact fluorescent lights
- Fire extinguishers
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Used cooking oil
- Pool chemicals
- Gasoline
- Kerosene
- Mercury switches
- Mercury
- Oil-based & latex paints
- Helium balloon tanks
- Barbecue propane tanks
- Rechargeable & button-cell batteries
