Dear Chief/Director/Sheriff,

The Police Academy would like to announce and make you aware of the dates for the annual "Police Youth Week," which is sponsored by the Somerset County Chiefs of Police. This year, the program will run from July 26-30, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM.

Participation in Police Youth Week will provide the attending student with an overview of various components of the criminal justice field. The program will be conducted through both classroom and practical based exercises providing the student with not only an academic understanding but also a "hands-on" experience. The program changes every year and is based on a four year curriculum to encourage the student to participate in the program the following year. It should be understood that due to the course design, it is not necessary to attend a previous year in order to attend a following year program.
